## **Brazos Bend Guardianship Services**

### **Guardianship Financial Assistance Program**

Brazos Bend Guardianship Services provides guardianship assistance to family members that need to obtain guardianship of an incapacitated loved one. There are eligibility guidelines for this program, and they are as follows:

1. The incapacitated individual must be at least 17 years and 6 months of age and must reside in Fort Bend County. Potential guardian must reside in Fort Bend County too.
2. The incapacitated individual must be incapacitated. The only proof of incapacity that will be accepted will be the Dr.'s Letter that must be completed by a licensed medical Dr.
3. The assistance program is only for family members seeking guardianship of the person only.
4. The assistance program is only for non-contested guardianships. This means no one will object to the incapacitated person getting a guardian.
5. Must be willing to attend an information session.
6. Must meet income and asset guidelines. Families with annual incomes up to 200% above the poverty level may qualify.
7. Potential guardian must be a US Citizen or have legal residency status
